

**10.02. Parking and snowplow restrictions.**

**10.021.** After any snow fall or after any accumulation of snow by reason of wind when said snow shall require plowing, no vehicles shall remain on any street, alley or public way within the City of Holland for a period longer than two consecutive hours without being moved. Said vehicles shall be moved to an area which has been plowed previously by the city or to private property.

**10.022.** A vehicle as defined herein shall include an automobile, truck, trailer, wagon or any other object or device which may block the street or prevent proper and efficient snow plowing or any other item defined as a vehicle or motor vehicle according to any statutes of the State of Minnesota.

**10.023.** Any vehicle which has not been moved and has remained at a location for period longer than two hours may be cited for a traffic violation of obstructing snow removal and said vehicle may be ordered to be removed. Any charges and expenses incurred in the removal and storage of said vehicle by law enforcement authorities' shall be charged to the owner of the vehicle.

**10.024.** Any violation of the terms of this subdivision shall be deemed a petty misdemeanor.

**10.03. Firearms.**

**10.031.** It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or shoot any type of firearms within the municipal limits of the City of Holland unless such person shall have obtained express written permission from the city council of the City of Holland.

**10.032.** For the purposes of Section 10.031, "firearms" shall mean any weapon from which is propelled any missile, projectile or bullet by means of explosive as or air, and shall include BB and pellet guns.

**10.033.** The provisions of this section shall not apply to law enforcement or military personnel while engaged in the course of their duties.

**10.034. Penalty.** Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
