

Traffic

7.01. Parking.

7.011. Vehicles shall be parked parallel to the curb, except where angle parking is indicated.

7.012. No parking shall be permitted in front of the fire hall.

7.013. No parking shall be permitted in front of the driveway or any intersection, crosswalk or on a sidewalk.

7.014. No parking shall be permitted in any area marked by the city with a yellow painted curbing; the areas so designated shall be adopted by the city council by resolution from time to time.

7.015. Any person who shall violate any of the terms of Section 7.01 shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor.

7.02. Speeding.

7.021. No vehicle shall exceed the speed of 30 miles per hour on any street within the city limits of the City of Holland.

7.022. Any person violating the terms of 7.02 shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor.

7.03. Parking.

No vehicle shall be parked on any municipal street for a time period in excess of 48 consecutive hours. Parking of a vehicle for a period in excess of 48 hours shall constitute a misdemeanor of the Holland City Code of 1982. In addition to said violation, any police officer may move a vehicle from the street to a garage or other place of safety when the vehicle is left unattended and constitutes a violation of this ordinance and obstruction to traffic or hinders snow removal or street maintenance operations. Such vehicles shall not be released until the fees for towing and storage are paid in addition to any fine imposed for violation of this ordinance

7.04. Exhibition Driving.

No person shall operate any vehicle in such a manner as to create or cause unnecessary engine noise, tire squeal, skidding, sliding or the throwing of sand or gravel upon acceleration or stopping, or in a manner as to simulate a race or temporary race or to cause such vehicle to unnecessarily sway or turn abruptly or to impede traffic. Any person who shall violate this provision shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

7.05. Truck Parking.

No person shall park or permit a truck to be parked on any municipal Street for a consecutive period longer than two hours. No truck shall be permitted to be parked on Main Street from Railroad Avenue to a point One and Three-fourths (1 3/4th) Blocks East of, Railroad Avenue except for the purpose of loading and unloading. Any person who shall violate this Section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
