The purpose of this meeting is to provide a fair and objective forum for property owners to appeal their valuation or classification.

Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic, and the requirements for social distancing, we will be offering a Zoom Virtual Meeting format for those taxpayers that do not want to personally attend the meeting but want to address the Commissioners as to their 2020 assessment value, which is for the Pay 2021 taxes.

Some items to be aware of:

- This meeting is to address taxpayer's concerns about their 2020 Assessment value which is for taxes due and payable in 2021;
- This meeting is not to discuss taxpayer's real estate taxes due and payable in 2020;
- ALL TAXPAYERS SHOULD HAVE CALLED THE COUNTY ASSESSOR'S OFFICE TO SCHEDULE A REVIEW AND TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT FOR THIS MEETING; IF NEEDED;
- When addressing the County Board of Appeal and Equalization, please state your name and the Parcel ID number you have concerns about;
- Each taxpayer will have 5-7 minutes to state their concern
- All motions will be made by a Roll Call vote;

Please understand that it is acceptable if you want to attend the meeting wearing a protective face mask.
