

## **JASPER CITY CURFEW FOR MINORS**

### **SECTION 9.13 CURFEW.**

- Subd. 1. Definition.** As used in this Section “minor” means a person under the age of sixteen (16) years.
- Subd. 2. Unlawful Acts.**
- A.** It is unlawful for any minor person to be or loiter upon the streets or public places between the hours of 10:00 o’clock P.M. and 5:00 o’clock A.M. of the day following.
  - B.** It is unlawful for any parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care or custody of any minor to allow or permit such minor to be or loiter upon the streets or public places in violation of this Section unless such minor is accompanied by a person of lawful age having such minor in charge.
  - C.** It is unlawful for any person operating, or in charge of, any place of amusement, entertainment or refreshment, or other place of business, to allow or permit any minor to be or loiter in such place in violation of this Section unless such minor is accompanied by a person of lawful age having such minor in charge. This subparagraph shall not be construed to permit the presence, at any time, of any person under age in any place where his presence is otherwise prohibited by law.
- Subd. 3. Exceptions.** Such curfew shall not apply to any minor student who is lawfully attending, going to or returning from school, church or community sponsored athletic, musical or social activities or events.

## **EDGERTON CITY CURFEW FOR MINORS**

### **SECTION 8.23 CURFEW**

- Subd. 1. Curfew – Minors Under the Age of Sixteen.** It is unlawful for any minor person under the age of sixteen (16) years to be or loiter upon the streets or public places between the hours of 10:00 o’clock P.M. and 6:00 o’clock A.M., unless such minor is accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Subd. 2. Curfew – Parents and Guardians.** It is unlawful for any parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care or custody of any minor person to allow or permit such minor person to be or loiter upon the streets or public places in violation of this Section unless such minor is accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Subd. 3. Curfew – Places of Amusement, Entertainment or Refreshment.** It is unlawful for any person operating, or in charge of, any place of amusement, entertainment or refreshment, or other place of business, to allow or permit any minor person to be or loiter in such place in violation of this Section unless such minor is accompanied by a parent or guardian. This Subdivision shall not be construed to permit the presence, at any time, of any person under age in any place where his presence is otherwise prohibited by law.
- Subd. 4. Exceptions.** Such curfew shall not apply to any students under the age of sixteen (16) years who are lawfully attending, going to or returning from school, church or community sponsored athletic, musical or social activities or events, or place of employment.
