Shredded Paper & Plastic Grocery Bags

(place in a clear bag and tie shut)



Tips:

- Scrape out excess food & empty all liquids.
- Bag shredded paper in a clear bag & tie shut before placing in your recycling bin.
- Bag grocery bags together in a clear plastic bag & tie shut before putting in your recycling bin.
- All other recyclables may be placed loosely in your recycling bin.
- **DO NOT** put medical, food, pet, or human waste in the recycling bin.
- **DO NOT** put electronics, hazardous waste, Styrofoam, ceramics, porcelain, toys, clothing or garden hoses in the recycling bin.

City Residents



Place your recyclable materials in the provided green and yellow cart. Curbside collection services will take place Bi-Weekly. Please have your cart to the curb prior to 6am on the day of collection. Carts must be faced so they open to the road.

Curbside Collection Dates

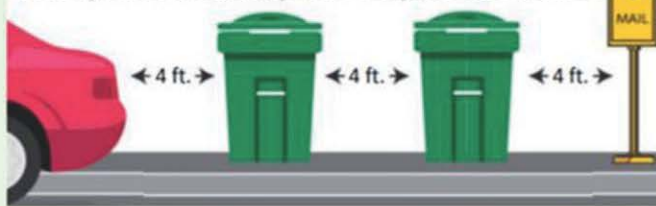
Holland, Ruthton, Woodstock– Every other **Monday**
